



Arrival and Dismissal of Pupils Policy

The school doors open at 8.50am.

First Class and Senior Infant Pupils are expected to arrive to school no later than 8.50am where the teachers bring the children directly to their classrooms at 8.50am.

Junior Infant Pupils are expected to arrive to school no later than 8.55am where the teachers bring the children directly to their classrooms at 8.55am.

At going home time, Junior Infant Pupils are brought to their line in the Junior Infant yard at 1.35pm to be collected (one by one) from the top of their line by a Guardian or Child Minder.

First Class and Senior Infant Pupils assemble in their classrooms and are walked by their Class Teacher to their line at going home time at 1.30pm where they are collected by a Guardian or Minder.

Information on school times is printed in the School's Fáilte Book which each parent receives upon acceptance of place for their child.

It is imperative that children are never left unattended on the premises before 8.50am or after closing time at 1.35pm. The Board of Management cannot undertake supervision of the children at that time and cannot accept any responsibility for children left unsupervised. The information is reiterated at the beginning of the school year to all parents by newsletter.
